

**YAVAPAI COUNTY ORDINANCE
2020-2
OUTDOOR FIRE ORDINANCE
REPEALING AND REPLACING
ORDINANCE 2008-1 AND
AMENDMENTS SET OUT IN
ORDINANCE 2012-1 AND ORDINANCE
2011-1 (FIREWORKS)**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE STAGED RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF COMBUSTION, OPEN FIRES, CAMPFIRES, AND FIREWORKS ON DESIGNATED LANDS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, ESTABLISHING FIRE ZONES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE ENACTMENT OF PROHIBITIONS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

I. TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the Yavapai County Outdoor Fire Ordinance.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect the public health, safety and welfare by establishing procedures for enactment and enforcement of emergency prohibitions and staged restrictions of combustion, open fires, campfires, and fireworks pursuant to A.R.S. §§11-251(63) and 36-1606 and establishing penalties for violation of such prohibitions.

III. DEFINITIONS

1. **“BOARD”** means the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors.
2. **“EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OFFICER”** means the Yavapai County Emergency Management Officer as designated by the Yavapai County Emergency Manager.
3. **“FIRE ZONE”** means a delineated portion of the unincorporated area of Yavapai County, having a designation and boundary as set forth and defined in Attachment 1, which may be the subject of a fire emergency determination pursuant to this ordinance.
4. **“UNINCORPORATED AREA”** means the unincorporated area of Yavapai County, exclusive of areas under the jurisdiction of the United States, the State of Arizona or a federally recognized Indian tribe.
5. **“FIRE DISTRICT”** means a special taxing district created pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Title 48, Chapter 5.
6. **“COMBUSTION”** means a chemical process of oxidization that occurs at a fast rate fast enough to produce heat and usually light in the form of a glow or flames.
7. **“OPEN FIRE”** means a fire where the products of combustion are emitted directly into the ambient air without passing through a stack or a chimney. This includes burning in a burn barrel.

8. **“CAMPFIRE”** means an open outdoor fire which is used only for the cooking of food or for providing personal warmth for human beings or for recreational purposes.
9. **“FIREWORKS”** means any combustible or explosive composition, substance or combination of substances, whether deployed on the ground or in the air or held in place by an individual or any device, or any article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect brought about by combustion, explosion, detonation, or deflagration that is a consumer firework or display firework as further defined in Arizona Revised Statutes § 36-1601.
10. **“PERMISSIBLE CONSUMER FIREWORKS”** means the type of permissible consumer fireworks as defined in Arizona Revised Statutes § 36-1601.
11. **“OUTDOOR FIRE PROHIBITION”** means a prohibition on open fires and campfires enacted by the Board pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 11-251(63).
12. **“FIRE BAN”** means a prohibition upon open fires, campfires, fireworks, and combustion when so declared by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors as provided for within this Ordinance.

IV. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

It shall be unlawful, in the designated “Fire Zones” and or the area of Jurisdiction, for one or more individuals, a corporation, limited liability company, partnership, association, firm, or other business or commercial entity to either directly or indirectly:

- A. Initiate, facilitate, maintain, cause or contribute to a campfire, an open fire, or use of fireworks when prohibited by this Ordinance; or
- B. Knowingly engage in an activity likely to result in combustion during a fire ban.

V. EFFECTIVE AREA/ FIRE ZONES

This Ordinance shall be effective in the Unincorporated Area of Yavapai County as defined herein. For purposes of this Ordinance, the Unincorporated Area shall be divided into three Fire Zones as depicted on the map attached hereto as Attachment 1 and incorporated by reference herein.

VI. DETERMINATION OF FIRE EMERGENCY

The Emergency Management Officer shall be responsible for determining when a fire emergency exists within one or more Fire Zones. A Fire Emergency Determination shall be based upon such factors as may be deemed relevant by the Emergency Management Officer including, but not limited to, weather, drought, organic fuels, or the imposition of fire restrictions within the boundaries of Yavapai County by federal, state or local agencies having the authority to impose such restrictions. Upon a determination that a fire emergency exists, the Emergency Management Officer shall issue a written Notice of Fire Emergency Determination and shall provide a copy of said Notice to the Board, specifying the basis on which the determination was made and requesting that the Board enact an Outdoor Fire Prohibition in one or more Fire Zones.

VII. ENACTMENT OF PROHIBITIONS AND STAGED RESTRICTIONS

If, following receipt of a Notice of Fire Emergency Determination and request for an Outdoor Fire Prohibition, the Board, by majority vote, may determine that restrictions on combustion, open fires, campfires, and fireworks are necessary to protect public health and safety. The Board may issue an Order enacting an Outdoor Fire Prohibition or Staged Restrictions or both. The Order shall specify the effective date of the Prohibition or Staged Restrictions, and the Fire Zone(s) within which the Prohibition or Staged Restrictions shall be effective. If the Emergency Management Officer requests immediate imposition of staged restrictions pursuant to Section VIII of this Ordinance, the Chairman of the Board may issue an interim Order imposing the restrictions, subject to ratification by majority vote of the Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

VIII. PROHIBITED FIREWORKS, STAGED RESTRICTIONS AND OUTDOOR FIRE PROHIBITION DEFINED

A. PROHIBITED FIREWORKS

1. Pursuant to A.R.S. 36-1606, the Board of Supervisors may:
 - a. Prohibit the sale of permissible consumer fireworks on any dates other than May 20 through July 6 and December 10 through January 3 of each year.
 - b. Prohibit the use of permissible consumer fireworks on any dates other than June 24 through July 6 and December 24 through January 3 of each year.
 - c. However, the Board of Supervisors may prohibit sale and use of permissible consumer fireworks during the above stated periods if a federal or state agency implements a stage one or higher fire restriction. Any prohibition during the above dates is limited to only the dates when the stage one or higher fire restriction is in place.
2. Notwithstanding the above, the Board of Supervisors may prohibit the use of permissible consumer fireworks at any time at the following locations:
 - a. Within a one-mile radius of the border of preservation lands owned by a city or town that has purchased more than fifteen thousand acres of land for preservation purposes;
 - b. Within a one-mile radius of the border of any municipal or county mountain preserve, desert park, regional park, designated conservation area, national forest or wilderness area.
3. Permits for Public Displays
 - a. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 36-1603 permits for public displays of fireworks in unincorporated areas within 50 miles of the County Seat shall be requested from the Board of Supervisors not less than five days prior to the date of display. A bond will be required. Upon the granting of a permit, the sale, possession, use and distribution of fireworks for the display shall be lawful for that purpose only. No permit is transferable or assignable.

B. STAGE 1 RESTRICTIONS:

1. Occurs in coordination with other governmental entities operating in Yavapai County, to include United States Forest Service (all forest lands inside and bordering Yavapai County), Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management, Bureau of Land Management, Yavapai County Fire Districts, and the tribal partners, (Bureau of Indian Affairs, Yavapai-Apache Tribe, and Prescott-Indian Tribe); when there is an increasing fire danger and/or increasing preparedness level, and the risks of keeping forest land open to all activities begins to be outweighed by the risks inherent in doing so. Stage 1 imposes restrictions aimed at preventing the start of wildfires caused by human activities that are known to be high fire risks, specifically smoking and campfires.
2. Prohibited Acts Under Stage 1 Restrictions:
 - a. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire or campfire except within a developed recreation site, or improved site.
 - b. **Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an outdoor area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials.**
 - c. Operating or using any equipment with an internal or external combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order meeting either the USDA Forest Service Standard 5100-1a (as amended), or appropriate Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) recommended practice J335(b) and J350(a) (36 CFR 261.52 (j)).

C. STAGE 2 RESTRICTIONS:

1. **This stage intensifies the restrictions currently in effect in Stage 1 by focusing on activities that have a relatively high risk of causing a fire start.**
2. The following acts are prohibited, in addition to the restrictions of Stage 1:
 - a. Discharging or using any kind of firework or other pyrotechnic device when prohibited by the Permitted Fireworks section above VIII(A).
 - b. Using an explosive.
 - c. Operating a chainsaw or other equipment powered by an internal combustion engine between the hours of 9:00 am to 8:00 pm.
 - d. Welding or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame.
 - e. Possession or use a motor vehicle off of Forest System Roads except when parking in an area devoid of vegetation within 10 feet of the roadway; and except for parking overnight in a developed campground and or trailheads.

D. OUTDOOR FIRE BAN

1. All outdoor burning is prohibited, to include, combustion, open fire, campfire, and fireworks, subject to the Permitted Fireworks section VIII(A) above, other than as follows:
 - a. Persons with a written permit or variance that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.
 - b. Any Federal, State, or Local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

IX. WRITTEN PERMIT OR VARIANCE

Individuals may apply for a written permit to engage in activity prohibited by this Ordinance except that permits for the public display of fireworks in unincorporated areas shall be submitted pursuant to the Permitted Fireworks section above. Such permits must be issued by the specific fire district in the district where the activity is to be performed, and must specifically describe the activity, location, and time at which the permit applies. For activities during a stage of restriction outside of a fire district a variance request must be submitted to the Yavapai County Emergency Manager for the activity who, in his or her sole discretion, shall grant or deny the variance. If a permit or variance is issued, it shall specifically describe the activity, location, and time and duration for which the variance applies.

A permit or variance may require that adequate fire suppression equipment and personnel, as indicated by the permit or variance, must be on site of the activity and readily available. The applicant for such permit or variance shall take reasonable and prudent measures to mitigate fire risk such as the removal of receptive fuels from the immediate area of activity and monitoring of changing weather conditions to include high winds. In the event of changing weather conditions not favorable for safe activity and the prevention of fire, the activity shall be suspended.

A written permit or variance issued according to this Ordinance does not relieve the applicant from liability associated with the activity and the potential for fire because of such activity.

X. TERMINATION OF PROHIBITION/STAGED RESTRICTIONS

Unless otherwise specified in the Order prohibiting the sale or use of fireworks or enacting the Outdoor Fire Prohibition or Staged Fire Restriction, the Order shall expire as of the date that the Emergency Management Officer issues a written determination that an emergency condition warranting a prohibition on the sale or use of fireworks, Outdoor Fire Prohibition or Staged Restriction no longer exists within one or more Fire Zones, or as of such other termination date as specified by the Emergency Management Officer in said written determination. The Emergency Management Officer shall file a copy of each determination issued pursuant to this Section in the Office of the Board of Supervisors.

XI. **PROHIBITED CONDUCT**

During the effective term of any Outdoor Fire Prohibition or Staged Fire Restriction enacted pursuant to this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful to engage in any activity prohibited by any authorized fireworks prohibition Staged Fire Restriction or Outdoor Fire Prohibition within any Fire Zone(s) subject to said Ordinance.

XII. **ENFORCEMENT**

This Ordinance may be enforced by any peace officer acting within the officer's area of jurisdiction.

XIII. **FAILURE TO OBEY A LAWFUL ORDER**

The failure to obey a lawful order by a peace officer to comply with the requirements of this Ordinance shall be a distinct and separate violation of this Ordinance.

XIV. **CONTINUING VIOLATION**

If any violation of this Ordinance is a continuing one, each day, or portion thereof, within which said violation continues shall be deemed a separate violation.

XV. **PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS**

Any person, firm, association, partnership, corporation or other legal entity who is convicted of a violation of this Ordinance is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor **and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$750 and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed 4 months.**

XVI. **FIRES EXEMPT FROM OUTDOOR FIRE PROHIBITIONS/STAGED RESTRICTION**

The following fires are exempt from any Outdoor Fire Prohibition enacted pursuant to this Ordinance:

1. Fires set or permitted by any public officer, federal, state or local, in the performance of the officer's official duties.
2. Fires set or permitted by the State Entomologist or Yavapai County agricultural agents for the purpose of disease and pest prevention.
3. Fires set or permitted by the United States, the State of Arizona, or any federally-recognized Indian tribe, or any of their respective departments, agencies or political subdivisions for the purpose of fire prevention or control, or watershed rehabilitation or control through vegetative manipulation.
4. Fires permitted by the Emergency Management Officer or designee or Fire District through a permit or variance. The conditions of the permit or variance, including permitted dates and the nature of the burning shall be clearly stated on any such permit or variance issued.
5. **Fires fueled by Liquefied Propane Gas (LPG) or Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) unless prohibited in the defined Staged Restrictions or Outdoor Fire Prohibition.**

XVII. REPEAL

This Ordinance repeals and replaces Ordinance 2008-1 and amendments thereto set out in Ordinance 2012-1 and Ordinance 2011-1 (Fireworks).

XVIII. EFFECTIVE DATE/DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

This Ordinance is an emergency measure intended to reduce the hazards created by open fires and campfires during periods of declared fire prohibitions or restrictions. It has been determined to be necessary to preserve the public peace, health or safety and shall, therefore, be effective immediately upon approval as provided by law.


